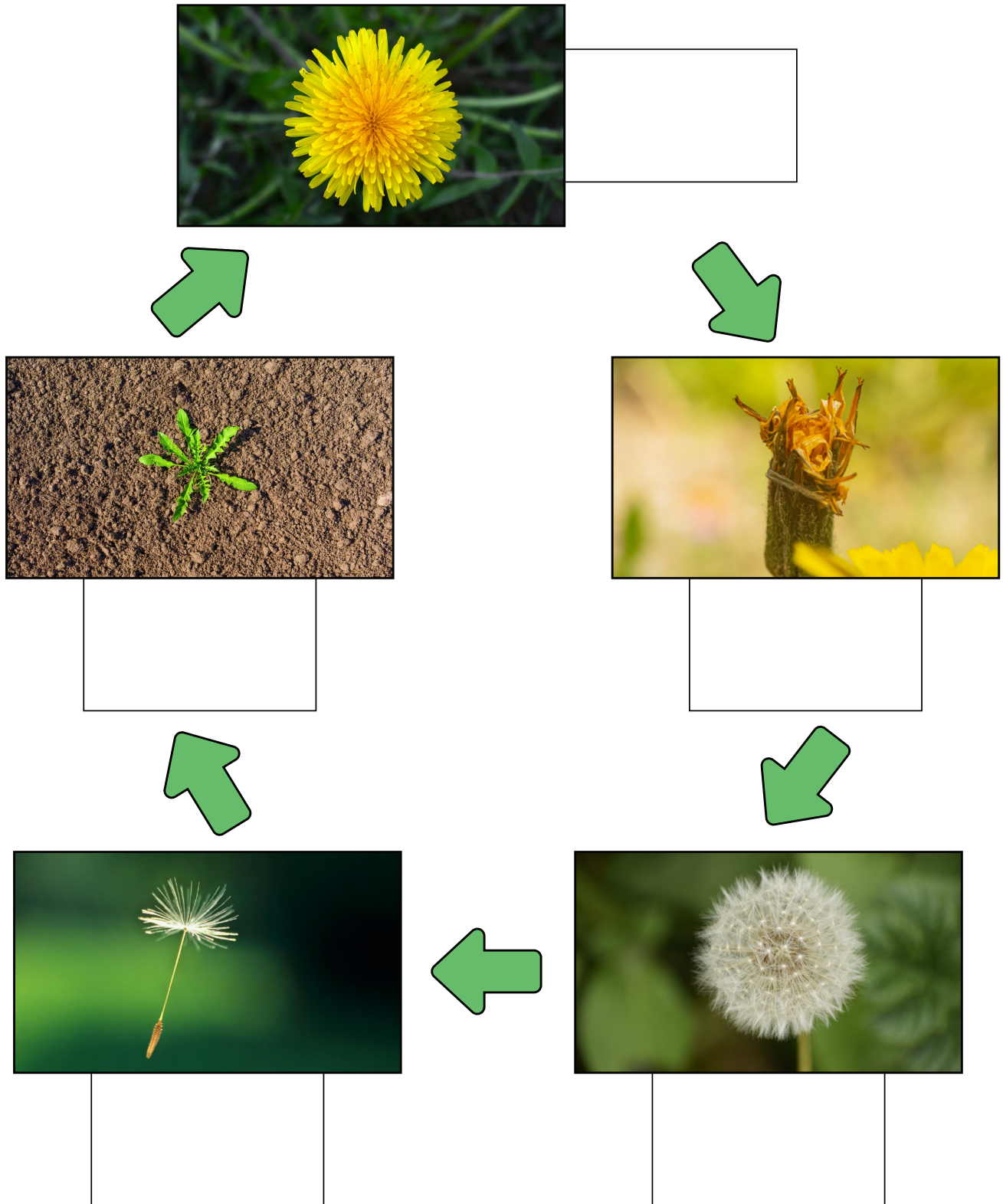


Stop and jot
