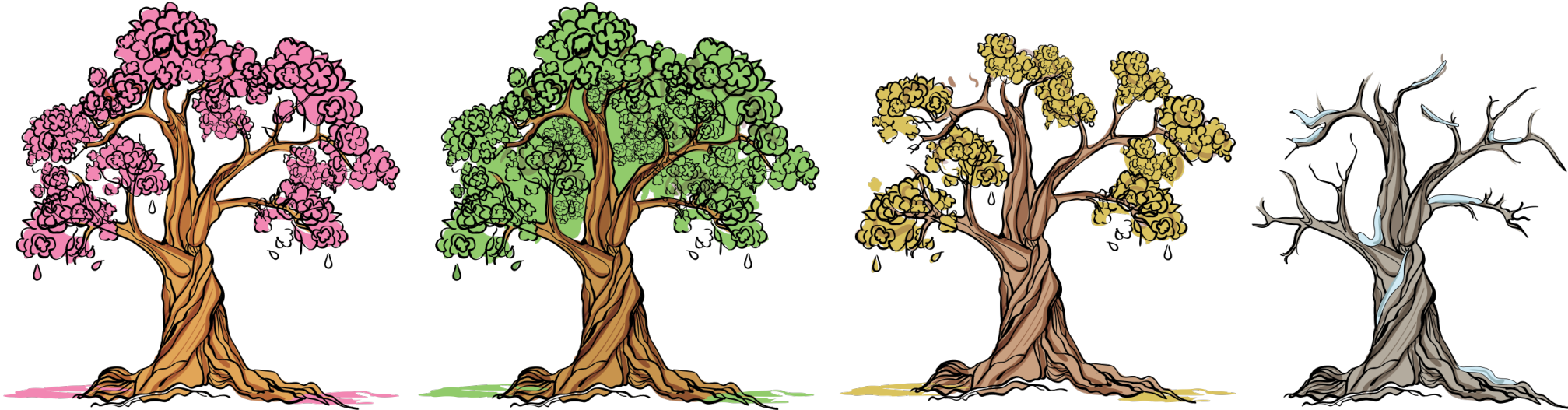


# Seasons

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Today we are going to look at summer. Summer is usually within the months of **June, July and August.**

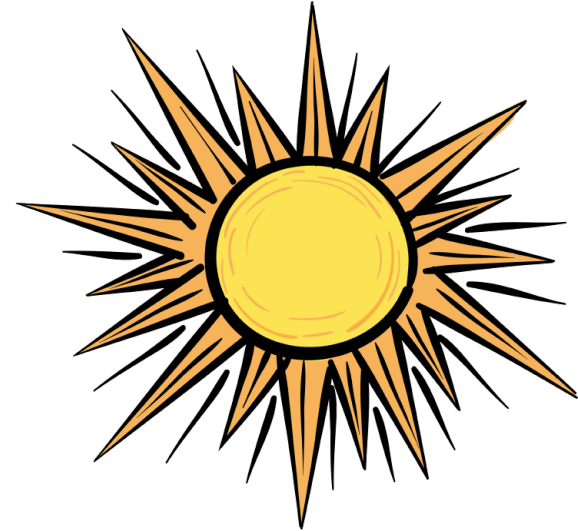

In summer the **days are at their longest** and the weather **is the warmest**. The trees are **full of leaves**.

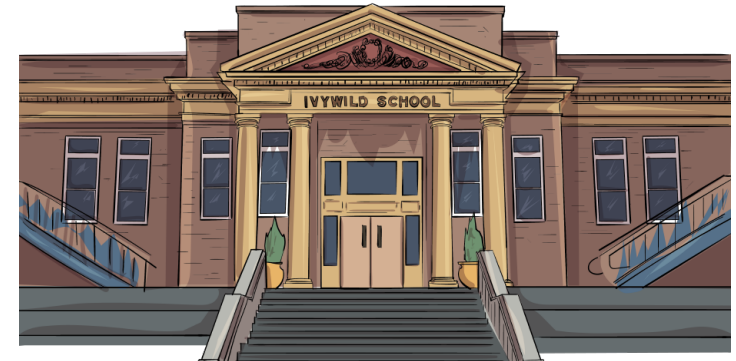
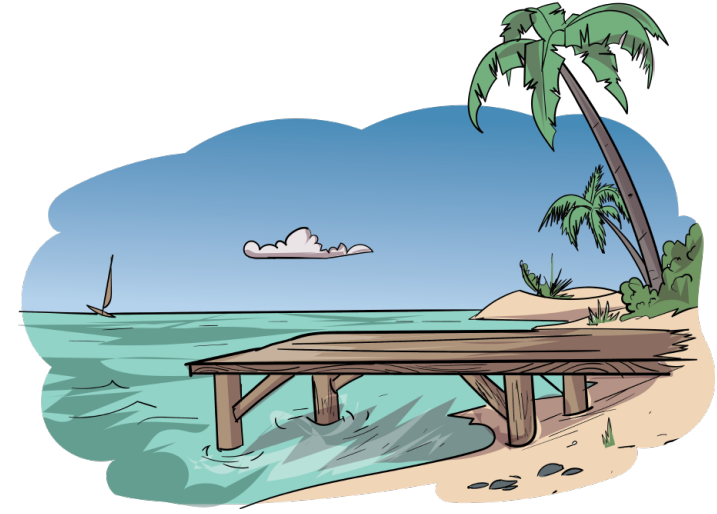


# Summer

**Is there anything else that happens in the summer months?**

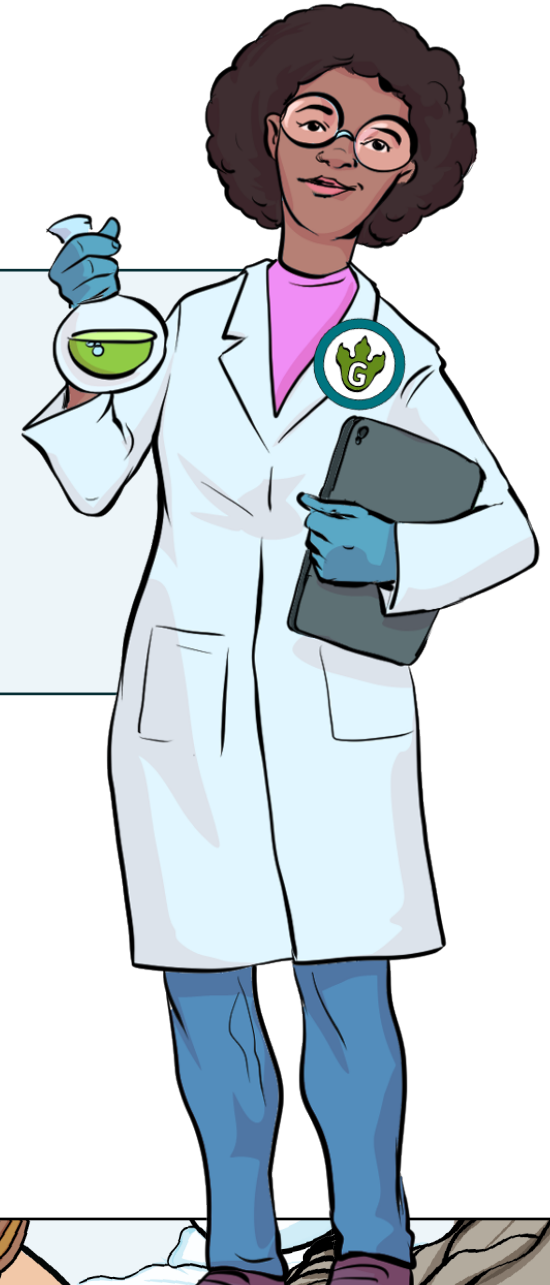


# Summer

Drink plenty of **water**.



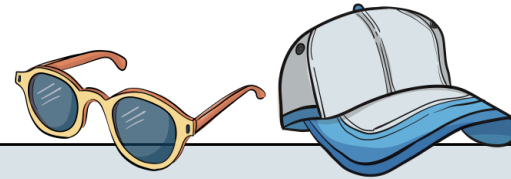
Make sure you cover up so you don't **burn**.
